Shiksha Sopan Science Cell

Innovative Evaluation Module in BLESS program

Shiksha Sopan is working on an innovative evaluation system. To get some change in evaluation system, we added five new evaluations methods and poster presentation is one of them. Poster presentation program was organized on 28th December, 2017 at Opportunity School, IIT Kanpur. Each student made his/her own poster from the course completed till December. Mr Vimal Kumar, MCA student, NIT Agartala and Mrs Chetna Mishra, Principal, Opportunity School were the evaluators for this program. A poster on Protozoa was the center of attraction of this program. Dr Sandeep Sangal, Professor, Department of Material Science and Engineering, IIT Kanpur and Dr H C Verma were there in the poster presentation program. They saw the posters and talk to the children.



Seven days workshop at SGM-IAPT Anveshika

Shiksha Sopan members are making efforts for spreading its effective teaching methodology for science education. A seven days workshop from 10th to 16th December, 2017 was organized at SGM-IAPT Anveshka, Indira Nagar, Kanpur. This workshop was organized with combined efforts of Shiksha Sopan Science Cell and Anveshika members. Basically this was a training program. Dr H C Verma and Mr Anurag Pandey from Shiksha Sopan, Mr Amit K Bajpai and Mr Yogesh Jha from Anveshika planned the experiments and their sequences.

A total of 23 teachers at class 6 to 8 level from three different states Pondicherry, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh were present there.

Dr Verma gave sessions on science teaching modules. He discussed on optics, mechanics, sound and electromagnetism. He also showed a lot of experiments on these topics. Teachers were given hands on experience on the experiments.

Three days workshop at Fatehpur

Mr Amit Kumar Bajpai and Mr Anurag Pandey from Shiksha Sopan gave a three day teachers workshop at Govt. Girls Inter College, Fatehpur from 6th to 8th December, 2017. More than 40 teachers from different schools were present there. Mr Amit Kumar Bajpai and Mr Anurag Pandey gave science demonstrations with very live discussions to enhance the understanding of teachers present there.



Each experiment was like a puzzle and through lots of debate, it was resolved. With examples from daily life situations these concepts were made more familiar to them.

One day workshop at Kanpur

Mr Amit Kumar Bajpai from Shiksha Sopan gave a one day teachers workshop at St Francis Xavier's Inter College, Kanpur on 21st December, 2017. More than 20 teachers from different schools were present there. It was very pleasant experience that all of them were very efficient and dedicated persons. Experiments showed by Mr Bajpai were very refreshing and exciting for all the participants present there.



Sopan Higher Education Cell

Higher Education Cell is a program in which children from underprivileged section are given financial assistance to continue studies beyond class 12. In the current year we got 18 applications so far for the support. A subcommittee consisting of Dr H C Verma, Mr Abhishek Savarnya, Mr Anurag Pandey, Mr Amit Kumar Bajpai and Mr Atul Kumar looked at the applications minutely in a meeting and selected 16 applications for support from Shiksha Sopan.



In this year we collected a total of Rs 1,10,000/- till date from all our sources for HE cell and made a commitment of Rs 2,02,600/- for selected 16 students. The total requested amount from the applicants is Rs 4,41,319/. In addition we might get occasional requests in the coming months. We appeal the community to donate for this cell.

Shiksha Sopan Anaupcharik Shikshan Kendra (SASK)

As usual SASK came out with very nice new programmes apart from the regular teaching. One of them is as follows:

Mathematics Festival

A function was planned to make an effort towards improvement in mathematics at SASK. On 22nd December, 2017 (Monday), SASK celebrated 130th birth anniversary of Srinivasa Ramanujan and gave a tribute to him. He was a great Indian mathematician. SASK organized this function for class 6th to class 8th children. Mr Sarvesh, M Tech, IIT Kanpur, organized a quiz competition at this occasion.

The quiz was organized for the children of class 6 to 8 in which different topics were addressed. This quiz was held in two different parts. In the first part, there was a written exam for the children. In the second part, five groups were made for the quiz competition. Sonam, Lakshmi and Mandavi from Team I got first prize. Nisha, Riya and Ankit from Team II got second prize and Shiya, Shivani and Kashish from Team III got third prize. Prizes were distributed on the same day.
