
Function at SASK

Joy of Learning workshop and NAEST

National Anveshika Experimental Skill Test (NAEST) is an all India competition of performing Physics experiments, conducted by Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT). All the experiments for NAEST are designed by Science cell team of Shiksha Sopan which are replicated by other Anveshikas in 25 cities.



Based on several rounds of these tests, 60 participants from all over country were called to Kanpur for Quarter final, Semifinal and Final round of NAEST. They camped at Sopan Ashram and other places for three days to go through the tests and participate in a Science workshop "Joy of Learning". The whole event was managed by Shiksha Sopan Volunteers in collaboration with IAPT and Vigyan Prasar, New Delhi.

Science cell team were busy in the month of September in designing the experiments for Semifinal and Final rounds of NAEST. They prepared 12 new experiments related to Mechanics, Electromagnetism, Waves and Optics. All the experiments were made and assembled at Sopan Ashram by our team. Mr. Ranjit Kumar coordinated the technical aspects of NAEST.







The inauguration of the workshop started by lighting the lamp in front of Maa Sarswati by Mr. Satish Tiwari, DIOS, Kanpur Nagar Mrs. Namita Singh, ADIOS, Kanpur, Mr. C. P. Gupta, Director, SGM International School, Kanpur and Dr. H. C. Verma, Coordinator, Joy of learning. Dr. H. C.
