The main events of this month were health camp at New SAC, development of some innovative experiments and workshops at different places by Shiksha Sopan Science cell and a science workshop by NSS students at Shiksha Sopan Anaupcharik Shikshan Kendra. Health Camp at New SAC

Shiksha Sopan organized a general health camp at New SAC on 26th September, 2015 (Saturday). Two of our Shiksha Sopan volunteers Mr Pawan Mishra and Mr Mukesh made telephonic conversation with students of Shiksha Sopan Higher Education cell and recipients of Dr V N Kulkarni Merit Scholarship program and explained about the medical camp and spread out the information.

Students were called at New SAC, IIT Kanpur at 03:00 PM. First of all we took a general information from each and every child. We measured their heights and weights. The camp started at 04:00 PM. Dr Umashankar, Consultant (Anaesthesia), UHM Hospital, Kanpur was the medical expert. Around 45 children with their parents came for health checkup. We registered all these students and these were sent to the doctor one by one.



These children felt very happy after discussing their health problems with the doctor. Dr Umashankar also told them that how one can prevent himself/herself from general diseases using some health care tips. Dr H C Verma, Mr Amit Kumar Bajpai, Mr Vipin Sharma, Mr Ranjeet Kumar and Mr Atul were present there all the time. Mr Anurag Pandey managed the whole program. Packed juice were distributed to every child.

We requested Dr Umashankar to come for second time for general health checkup for more children of Shiksha Sopan and he agreed.
