Final Selection of Dr V N Kulkarni Merit Scholars 2017

The sub-committee of Dr. V N Kulkarni Merit Scholarship was very active in the last month. As reported in our previous newsletters (May 2017), Sopan organized the scholarship examination at Opportunity School IIT Kanpur, made an economical survey of the screened candidates and on the basis of the Survey report, the selection-committee selected 17 students for Dr V N Kulkarni Merit Scholarship 2017.

On 26th July 2017, Shiksha Sopan organized Scholarship Distribution Function to give the scholarship amounts to the recipients. All the students of the new batch of scholarship and the old batch were given scholarship amount in this function. Parents of all the scholars and Sopan volunteers were also present in the programme.
