Dear Readers, Greeting from the Shiksha Sopan family. In the month of July Varity of events conducted like scientific excursion, science show in village, Jawahar Navodya Vidylaya PGT Physics workshop at Noida. Alumni meet of SASK students and volunteers. Regular programes like evening learning centers, Library, Sopan Anaupcharik Shikshan Kendra are running well. The brief report of this month is given below for you.

Central programs

Scientific excursion at Sopan Ashram 7 - 8 July

The Scientific temperament inculcating among the students is noticeable and Sopan Ashram is completely ready for it. The whole campus is developed in such a way that gives a great feeling of Science in every way possible.

A two-days scientific excursion program was organized at Sopan Ashram. Class 9 students of Shri Ram Janki Inter College, Bithoor, Kanpur visited in group of 40. First day 40 children with their teachers came. Sopan Volunteers and M.Sc students, those who were participating in Competence course helped during the whole visit. Mr. Ranjit Kumar, Coordinator Science Cell managed both the days of visit. First a brief description about Sopan and its activities were given and after that children were divided into three groups for Lab visits. We prepared three labs for these groups. One of the labs was acquainted with exciting experiments like primary and secondary colors, center of mass, electrostatic charges, etc. In second lab, experiments were arranged related to magnetism. Similarly, in the third lab or room, scientific instruments and tools were in display. Children also learnt how to solve different type puzzles/tasks during their lab visits.

Students visited all three labs, in each lab we engaged them for about forty minutes. After forty minutes every group was swapped for the other lab. Next day another group of class 9th visited. This visit planned by Mrs. Rita Sanghal and she was also present with the manager of the school to motivate the children. Children learnt many more things including how to use different tools during cutting, filling, drilling, hammering etc. Students wanted to spend more time at Sopan Ashram with Verma sir and others. They promised us that they will visit again and see other experiments which they couldn't see in this visit.







Small Experiments Big Learning

The children coming to study in the Sopan Ashram evening Center are provided weekly experimental class. The Science cell team members Mr. AMIT KUMAR BAJPAI, Mr. RANJIT KUMAR, Mr. Yogesh Jha, and Mr. Vinay Kumar Mishra give weekly classes to these children. Live experiments showed to the students by the team related to the topics which they



learnt in their theory classes were cleared very much through this. The experiments are supposed to be very small and low cost but the learning through them is too big. All the students are always excited to join experimental class and they wait for this weekly class.

STAPPLE Program

This is a very hit program of Science Cell, Science Tables At Public Places and Learning Experience (STAPPLE) which is coordinated by Mr. Vinay Kumar Mishra. He chose one village every month and visit that place, meet the villagers and tell them about the Program. One of the villagers coordinated with Vinay ji and arranged the session.

This time the program was conducted in Mangalpur village on 27th July. It was conducted in the Milan Kendra. This place and program arranged by Shri Gangaram Ji. A total of 11 eye catching experiments were demonstrated by our Sopan Team Members. The efforts were to develop an awareness of education in those who were present. After the scientific session, a competition related to the session was organized in which almost all the questions were answered correctly by the audience. Those who gave the correct answer were given a diary and a pen from Shiksha Sopan. At the end of the program, everyone sang a song by Sopan Dheyay Geet, "Desh Hame Deta hai Sab Kuchh." The whole progam was very encouraging for audience as well as performers of the experiment.







Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya Workshop

18-21 July, a 4-day workshop was held in Training Center of JNV at Noida Sector 62. 38 PGT Physics of Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) attended the workshop. Dr. H. C. Verma from Shiksha Sopan, Mr. Anil Kumar Gupta, member of JNV and Commissioner Training of JNV, Mr. Ranjit Kumar inaugurated the workshop.
