The main programs were Shiksha Sopan's Annual function, Republic Day celebrations, Swami Vivekanand Jayanti celebration at Shiksha Sopan Anaupcharik Shikshan Kendra and Mehndi and Fancy dress Competitions at New SAC on the auspicious occasion of Basant Panchami.

Annual Function

This year Shiksha Sopan celebrated its 14th Annual function. The program was held at Sopan Ashram, Nankari near Navsrajan Saraswati Vidya Niketan on 25th January, 2015 (Sunday). Basant Panchami celebration

The Basant Panchami is celebrated as a festival in remembrance of Goddess Saraswati. Shiksha Sopan celebrated Basant Panchami just one day before the Annual function i.e. on 24th January, 2015 (Saturday) at New SAC, IIT Kanpur. Mehndi and Fancy Dress competitions were organized by Shiksha Sopan on this auspicious occasion. Two competent teams of judges judged these competitions. Mrs Chetna Mishra, Vice principal, Opportunity School IIT Kanpur, Shri Suraj Verma and Mrs Pragya Khandekar judged Mehndi competition. Mrs Deepa Danayak and Mrs Nirupma also helped these judges. Mehndi Competition

Mehndi competition was divided into three categories, namely, children studying in class 4th to 8th, class 9th to 12th and the third category for elders. A total of 63 children participated in this competition. Miss Rani from first category, Miss Lakshmi from second category and Miss Ranjana from third category got the prizes for their outstanding performances. The prizes were distributed on next day in the Annual Function of Shiksha Sopan. Three consolation prizes in each category were also distributed with these outstanding performances.

Fancy Dress Competition

This competition was open for anyone up to class 12th. Each child came on the stage representing a special character, dressed accordingly. He/she then spoke some dialogues related to the character. 23 children participated and represented almost all sections of the society such as teacher, beggar, poet, domestic servant, vegetable vender, political leader, Lord Krishna, Goddess Saraswati, a tree, etc. Master Vinay got first prize, Miss Anamika got second prize and Miss Muskaan got third prize. The prizes to these children were also distributed on next day in the Annual Function of Shiksha Sopan. Seven consolation prizes were also distributed with these three.
