The month of January 2020 was very special for every person who is directly or indirectly associated with Shiksha Sopan. There were several festivals celebrated by Sopan but the main source of happiness was that our guide and Patron Dr. H C Verma has been nominated for Padam Shree. January witnesses another National festival, Republic day which was celebrated with great joy.

Republic day Program

Apart from the functions at the centers, Shiksha Sopan celebrated a central Republic Day program at Sopan Ashram. This was conceived by Shri Amit Kumar Bajpai in order to make an impact on the local society. Our senior volunteers and coordinators from different centers attended the function. The highlight was invitation to local people who came in good number. Especially people active in different kind of social activity participated in our program.

The Flag Hosting was done by Dr H C Verma and other prominent persons from the locality. This was followed by National Anthem and then poetry recitation and expressing their commitment to the Nation by several speakers.

As the Padma awards were announced on 25th January only, all present were in jubilant mood. Speaker after speaker spoke about the social initiatives of Dr H C Verma and congratulated him. In his speech Dr. Verma gave credit to this award to all the ground level Shiksha Sopan workers whose dedicated efforts brought the whole work in lime light. He also narrated how this award came to him as surprise as he never applied for any award. He thanked IIT Kanpur for nominating him and processing the file so meticulously.



Dr H C Verma then talked about the Republic Day and told that the real strength of a Nation is in its people. And as long as people of India are committed to Indian values, our Nation will remain strong. Earlier Shri Vinay Kumar Mishra recited his poem in which he put up some negative sides prevailing in India to which Dr Verma was responding.
