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

As you know, Shiksha Sopan is always focused towards the development the education environment in the society and for that we are doing regular programs. In December month, several activities were planned and performed. We would like to share our experiences and work details with you.

Central programs

Science Tables At Public Places and Learning Experiences (STAPPLE)

A wonderful step has been taken to spread awareness among the public and develop a scientific attitude. This whole project is sponsored by Mr. Ajay Lohia, Threads India Pvt Ltd, Kanpur. On 5th December, 2021, Shiksha Sopan children in supervision of Mr. Vinay Kumar Mishra, a dedicated volunteer of Shiksha Sopan, organized a STAPPLE programe in a village called Para Pratappur. This village is 6Km from Sopan Ashram. The team members reached at the village around 11AM using their cycle riding of one hour. One of the guardian Shri Dinesh Kumar Jee coordinated the programe with Vinay ji. He arranged local facilities like neat and clean venue, tables and chairs, mat for the audience and informed the villagers about this programe. In this way we enhanced our relations with villagers.

Mr. Vinay started the programe with a song. Student of Sopan demonstrated eye caching science experiments. Audience were excited to see the wonderful magic-like experiments. Brief explanations were also given by the children. Everyone expressed their happiness by clapping. They were amazed to see the performance of younger children of Sopan. They wished for their bright future. Sopan children organized a quiz and asked very common questions related to Science. Vinay Ji gifted the stationary items whoever gave the correct answer of the question.



First Sunday Club (FSC) at Sopan Ashram

FSC is a very rich and most popular monthly programme, specially for Physics teachers at Sopan Ashram. This programme is jointly SGM-IAPT ANVESHKA and Shiksha Sopan. On 5th December 2021, First Sunday of the month, around 25 teachers came to Sopan Ashram to enjoy the Physics with great personality of Physics Dr. H. C. Verma. The session started at 10AM. This is a platform where teachers enrich themselves through discussions, remove their misconceptions of Physics, learn teaching skills, to learn human values. Learning from natural environment gives additional positivity at Sopan Ashram. Every visitors felt this positivity and expressed their views with us.

This month mostly Q-A session happened. Dr. Anita Singh asked a question related to moment of inertia and Verma sir replied and cleared the doubts. Mr. Ramendra Kushwaha from Auraiya started discussion on gas lighter which we use in our kitchen. Pressure difference, piezoelectric effect, spark due to ionization of air were discussed. We also showed to glow of red LED using this small and handy gas lighter.



Teacher's workshop at Bhopal

After a long time teachers workshop was conducted Physically at Bhopal. Mrs. Jaishree Kanwar, Director, Sagar Public School (SPS), invited Dr. H. C. Verma and his team. Mr. Amit K Bajpai, Mr. Ranjit Kumar and Mr. Vipin Sharma went to Bhopal to conduct the workshop specially for SPS teachers. The dates were 6th to 8th December, 2021. On 6th December the workshop was conducted for Science teachers teaching std 6th to 8th. Verma sir and his team gave wonderful sessions on force and pressure. In one of the session teachers asked their doubts and Verma sir cleared them. Next day the workshop was done for PGT Physics. Around 35 teachers participated. In the session we introduced magnets, electricity and electromagnetism to them. Verma Sir demonstrated and discussed Physics deeply with them. He also taught teaching skills during the workshop. Teachers and the management of the SPS were very happy to attend the session.



On 8th December two hundred students from the four branches of SPS were invited to interact with Verma Sir. They offered a warm welcome to Verma Sir by standing ovation. Their faces were shining and smiling to see Verma Sir in the auditorium of SPS. Verma Sir motivated these students by sharing his own life story. On the same day Verma Sir interacted with teachers from different schools/colleges of Bhopal at Regional Science Center, Bhopal. The search and research group and the science center organized this interactive session of Verma sir. Physically about hundred teachers were invited due to covid precautions in the hall. The session was also broadcast online for the whole Nation.

The new initiative SOpan OutReach MAjlis

SOORMA was described in previous Newsletter. The SOORMA sessions were conducted in the month of December. The highlights of the sessions are given below

- ❖ The first session was conducted online Ms. Neeraj Taneja as a main resource person on 11th December. She demonstrated the applications of "Phyphox", a mobile app. She hit a ball on the ground and detected the sound of every collision between the ball and the ground using the app. This data were used resulted in a discussion on factors affecting the coefficient of restitution e . The demonstrations using another app "accelerometer" were also discussed in the session. The session was attended by 11 teachers and it went on for an hour.
- ❖ The second SOORMA session was conducted on 26th December 2021. This session was conducted by Mr. K .K Mishra and Ms. Smita Fangaria in which a group of 9 teachers gathered on that day for an offline session based on electric fields. It involved discussions on some misconceptions, demonstrations and hands on activities.

There were some **demonstrations shown on photoelectric effect** by using a handmade electroscope. The process of charging by induction was discussed in depth. The ejection of electron was shown by using an ultraviolet light source. This session was also important because it was one of the closing programme of celebrations of the centenary year of Einstein winning the Nobel Prize in 1921 for photoelectric effect.

Mathematics day
