Central Programs

Einstein NObel Prize Centenary Year Celebration (ENOPCYC 2021)

As we know, the all time great Scientist Albert Einstein got a noble prize for his explanation of Photoelectric effect in the year 1921 and we are in the centenary year of this event. Albert Einstein has contributed so much in the field of Physics and his struggles are true inspiration for any individual and society.

Dr. H. C. Verma decided to conduct sessions of ENOPCYC all over India. He planned and called a meeting of all Anveshika coordinators, Shiksha Sopan volunteers, and other resource persons who are associated with NAEST earlier. Around 50 people turned out in the meeting. Prof. Verma presented his ppt and showed demonstration of Photoelectric effect. He motivated all the people present to arrange this program for students, teachers and masses. The main theme of the event is to let people know about his life, struggles, achievements, work etc. This is very relevant at this moment as the Nation is entrapped in Corona fear and many of our young generation is facing frustration. Einstein's struggles on personal, social and academic fronts in the initial years can be very motivating for them. Dr. Jitendra Singh, a Scientist in DRDO, active volunteer of Shiksha Sopan and one of the Anveshika Resource person was requested to be the overall coordinator of this event.

Shiksha Sopan in collaboration with SGM-IAPT Anveshika decided to organize ENOPCYC event in masses, especially in UP region under its DOSTI project. Mr. Amit K Bajpai, Secretary, Shiksha Sopan is coordinating this series of events. He wrote letters to schools, colleges, institutions, NGOs and Education Department authorities about this event and invited them to organize such events in their influence circles.



Schools/Colleges were closed and the so called online classes were not effective to make them work hard and utilize their time in a proper manner. Amit K. Bajpai and Mr. Abhishek Dass decided to do a combined session with the main focus to learn something absolutely new about their own strengths. Mr. Dass delivered a one hour talk with the title "Nurture your Nature and Skill". He started his talk with interactive activity. In this activity, Abhishek showed cartoon pictures and asked the audience to draw these cartoon on paper. This interested everyone and even those who had never got a chance to do drawing, started working on. Even for students who had drawing classes in their schools, cartoon drawing was something very different and they were excited to make the cartoons. Soon most of the students started picking up the skill. Abhishek Ji gave instructions and trained them to draw the cartoon easily.



He also focused that everything available in the universe is necessary. He drew a Jungle and asked people to tell what type of things are present in the Jungle, Audience spoke different names one by one which was listed. 
Barasirohi Evening Center (BEC)
