Dear Readers, Greetings from the Shiksha Sopan family. In the month of May Shiksha Sopan conducted and participated in different events, First Sunday Club for teachers, Majlish for teachers, Technology day with Amar Ujala, 3 days residential camp of 11th and 12th students at Sopan Ashram, Selection of students and Scholarship distribution of VNK. Regular activities of Shiksha Sopan running smoothly like evening learning centers, Sopan library. Brief report of all activities are written below for you.

Central programs

VNK Scholarship

As we know, Shiksha Sopan conducts Dr. V. N. K. Merit scholarship Examination every year for classes 5th ,8th and 10th. But for the past two years, due to covid outbreak, we were not able to conduct the exam. So we had decided to conduct the VNK exam this year. We changed the method of the selection of scholars from the previous years, no economic survey will be done specially for this examination. The students will get scholarships only on the basis of their merit.

On 24th April 2022, the VNK Scholarship exam was conducted at Opportunity School, IIT Kanpur, where 200 students were enrolled, and 170 students appeared for the exam. The exam was conducted very smoothly under the supervision of Mr. Atul Kumar (Coordinator). Designated volunteers checked answer sheets. After this, the results were announced on 5th May 2022.

The scholarship distribution program was conducted on 8th May at Sopan Ashram, where key members of Shiksha Sopan along with Trustees of Sopan Trust distributed the Scholarship. The program was hosted by Mr. Atul Kumar and Mr. Amit Kumar Bajpai. The scholarship was distributed by Dr. Chandan C. S Sharma from Updhyay, IIT BHU, Dr. IIT Hyderabad, Anil Kumar Gourishetty from IIT Roorkee, Mr. Vinay Kumar Trivedi, Manager, Shree Shakti Degree College, Dr. H. C. Verma, and Mr. Ranjan Bhaiya. At last High Tea was organized for all the guests, scholars of VNK and their guardians.







First Sunday Club (FSC)

In association with SGM-IAPT Anveshika Shiksha Sopan conducts First Sunday Club on every first Sunday of the month at Sopan Ashram. This club was basically dedicated to all teachers. 30 teachers from different places were present on 1st May 2022 at Sopan Ashram. Mr. Yogesh Jha welcomed all the teachers in the club and demonstrated one simple activity to them. After that teachers discussed on

the questions asked by one of the teacher.

In this month Verma sir specially showed research lab (SUREELA) which was established at Sopan Ashram. Verma sir introduced and explained the working of the equipments which were available in the lab like Hydraulic press, different type furnaces, Liquid nitrogen and its container, pressure gauge, vacuum pump, temperature sensor, thermocouples etc.



Sopan Outreach- Majilis (SOORMA)

Two online sessions were conducted by team SOORMA. Mrs. Smita fangariya coordinated the sessions, the brief description of the sessions are as follows-

First Session: Date: 14thMay, 2022, Resource person: Mr. Amit Kumar Bajpai,

Timings: 4:30pm to 5:30pm, **Topic**: Magnets, **Attendees**: 25

Mr. Amit K. Bajpai started his session by showing various types of magnets and then created interesting situations using them. He put two bar magnets together in a way their capacity of attracting iron pieces was greatly reduced and then made some changes in the arrangement which restored their capacity of attracting the iron pieces. This led to a discussion on the role of keepers used for the magnets. He demonstrated the magnetic properties of a razor blade and how it could be floated on water to behave as a magnetic compass. He also showed that a steel ball bearing kept at the periphery of a cylindrical magnet on its flat circular edge always moved towards its centre. This was a demonstration of the fact that the strength of the magnetic field of cylindrical magnet is large at the centre of its flat circular face as compared to the periphery. He also showed beautiful experiments using ring magnets.

Everyone loved it when he demonstrated the paramagnetic and diamagnetic behavior of certain substances. He ended the session by creating an enthralling situation in which a person was sitting on a plastic chair. The chair was charged by beating it with a cloth. And to everyone's amazement he could create and show a spark by bringing his finger very close to the finger of the person on the chair.

It was an amazing session. Mr. Yogesh helped him in all the demonstrations done online.

The session was conducted jointly by Sarmistha Ma'am and Ameet Sir. They showed short videos based on Alternating current circuits created by Sarmistha Ma'am herself and posed quiz questions based on the video. It was a very thought-provoking session for all the teachers attending the session.
