COmbined Shiksha Sopan Activities (COSSA)

Sopan Ashram is coming up as a vibrant centre of social strengthening. People visiting this place often express the feeling of positivity and confidence. It is all due to the efforts of our Sopan volunteers who work so hard with the only aspiration of contributing to make many-many lives happy and useful.

School Visits

Sopan Ashram is steadily progressing as a Science Tourism destination. In May 2023 the following schools visited Sopan Ashram under the programe of Development Of Science Tourism Initiative (DOSTI)

(i) Scholar Mission School, Bithoor Road, Kanpur came to Sopan Ashram on 17th and 18th May, 2023 with their 80 students along with their teachers. These students belong to std 6 to 8. First both the groups in consecutive days interacted with Dr. H. C. Verma. Children expressed their happiness by



their smiling faces. Students asked questions from Dr. H. C. Verma sir , one of the students asked about volcano. Dr. Verma explained the concept of volcano in a very simple manner suitable for Std 6 but still with all the details. Students visited Sopan labs, interacted with Sopan team and experienced that Science experiments are so simple to-do and easy to understand. They promised to Sopan team that they will create and perform these kind of experiments in their home and decorate the school lab with these small experiments.

(ii) Another school, Virendra Swaroop Education Centre, Cantt, Kanpur visited Sopan Ashram with their 28 students and 4 teachers on 22nd May 2023. They stayed at Sopan Ashram for five hours. They interacted with Dr. Verma and visited our labs. Mr. Amit K Bajpai demonstrated them Photo Electric Effect (PEE) using UV lamp, hand made electroscope and a PVC pipe. Students and their teachers were amazed to see live experiment of PEE with simple hand made materials. Other labs were also visited by these students, where they interacted with Mr. Ranjit, Mr. Yogesh K Jha, Mr. Vinay Mishra, Mr. Himanshu and Mr. Ajay.

RC Aircraft Making and Night Sky watching Workshop

Remote Control (RC) Aircraft making and Night Sky watching workshop was held at Sopan Ashram from 23rd to 26th May, 2023. It was fully residential workshop. We selected 13 teachers from First Sunday Club (FSC) and 4 volunteers from Shiksha Sopan, especially for this workshop. The lighting of the lamp ceremony was done on 23rd May by Dr. H. C. Verma, Mr. Vaibhav Varun, Managing Director, Aviakul Pvt. Ltd and Dr. D. C. Gupta from IAPT RC-4.

First we gave theory session of Aircraft to the participants, most of the theory sessions were given by Mr. Vaibhav Varun. Participants made their aircraft in their own in supervision of Mr. Shabri from Aviakul. Night sky watching sessions were conducted by Mr. Manish Yadav. All members saw moon through reflecting telescope in supervision of Mr. Manish.





Three popular talk also conducted in this workshop. All three were from faculty members of Mechanical Engineering Department of IIT Kanpur. One was delivered by Dr. Sachin Yashavant Shinde on topic **Role of Flexibility in Hovering, Swimming and Flying**. The lecture was very good, knowledgeable and was greatly appreciated by everyone. Another talk was delivered by Dr. Pranav Johsi on Bernoulli's effect. It was mostly on the format of a question - answer session. Participants asked questions to him. Third lecture delivered by Dr. Sameer Khandekar, It was motivational lecture. The topic of the lecture was "**Going Beyond Our Confines**". It contained how we can do better for our life, our society as well as for our Nation. On the last day of the workshop aircrafts were flying which were made by the participants. In a separate session on the same day the resource persons demonstrated models of rover, rocket, etc. to the audience.





First Sunday Club (FSC)

On every first Sunday of the month, we conduct a teachers' meeting which is called First Sunday Club, It is joint venture of Shiksha Sopan and SGM-IAPT Anveshika. Teachers from different districts come to join FSC. It was a two-hour event conducted at Sopan Ashram. On 7th May, 2023. The whole club activities ran under the supervision of Dr. H. C. Verma.

In this month we discussed reflection and its laws. Dr. Verma showed reflection

Phenomenon using three wooden sticks. He also explained laws of reflections. When we talk about second law of reflection, we say incident beam, reflected beam and normal should be lie on a same plane, but we find that many teachers and students don't understand about this plane. Dr. Verma explained the plane



and also told them about the technical difference between normal and perpendicular. It was too simple to demonstrate these things using three wooden sticks.

Sopan Anaupacharik Shikshan Kendra (SASK)

Together with formal education of children, SASK conducts several programs to develop variety of skills in them. The following activities were conducted in this month.

Information related to Chandra Grahan (Lunar Eclipse)

On May 5, the children of Shiksha Sopan were told about the lunar eclipse. Seema Verma ji demonstrated the lunar eclipse through a picture and also demonstrated it in 3D in the class, she used torch, ball and globe. She also gave a very rich information about the phases of the moon to the students.



Craft Activity

Children of class 2nd to class 4th were taught how to make rabbit using colorful A4 paper. This activity was shown to the children by Sunita ji and Ruby ji. Children then made beautiful colorful rabbits on their own and showed them with much more confidence. These kinds of activities create confidence in them.



Voting Awareness

Councilor elections for Nagar Nigam were held in the month of May. SASK conducted a voting awareness program. The motive of this program was to make people aware of using their vote to form a strong team for governess. In this program, SASK coordinator asked students to make their parents and neighbor's aware about the importance of voting. They also made slogan
