Paper Bags



CVRAMANS project

Shiksha Sopan has taken up a project called "Creating Video Resources for developing Aptitudes in Mathematics and new inSight" This is focused on primary school Mathematics of UP Board. We feel that the present compartmentalization of the topics in five textbooks is putting up more pressure on the children, especially in the initial years and they are getting disconnected from mathematics. The idea is to make a single study material encompassing all the topics listed in class 1-5 syllabus. This can be used by teachers at different paces depending on the level of the audience students. The teaching schemes have to be very different and we will be creating video lectures to assist teachers to adopt the new methodology.

The project is proposed to the Outreach committee of IITK and we are likely to get some financial support from the committee.

We have gotten a space in Type-1 Community Center for our Ambitious Library project. We will formally launch the Library at this venue on 14th November, Children's Day.
