Two days Workshop at Jharkhand, Bihar

Shiksha Sopan Secretary Dr H C Verma gave a two day physics teaching workshop on 'Mastering Physics Through Experiments' organized by Hazaribag Sahodaya School Complex in collaboration with Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribag at Vivekanand Auditorium on 22nd and 23rd August, 2015. On first day, Dr Verma gave two lectures in two different sessions. In first session, a total of 500 students from Hazaribagh attended the workshop and in next session 60 MSc students form Vinoba Bhave University attended the workshop.

Next Day, near about 60 teachers and some of the B.tech students were present there and attended the lecture. Dr Verma talked about the methodology of science teaching. He also discussed some other experiments among all the teachers and this teaching methodology was appreciated by these teachers.

Mr Arvind Pathak, our senior resource person was also there and showed a lot of experiments based on light and electricity. Science Workshop at Fatehpur
