## Science Cell



### FAT PAP SAM at Anveshika

Shiksha Sopan in collaboration with SGM-IAPT Anveshika organized Fun And Thrill Packed Activity Program for Science And Mathematics (FAT PAP SAM) at Indira Nagar on 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2013 for 60 students of class 11 from Children Public School, Fatehpur. The 6-hour programme started with lighting lamp of knowledge. The first academic programme was a talk by Dr H C Verma in which he described the struggle some of the very successful scientists had to put up. He took three cases, namely Dr C V Raman, Michael Faraday and Madam Curie and brought out their commitment to Science despite all odds.

Mr. Ranjit Kumar with Mr. Deepak Mishra organized a one hour hands-on activity session with the students. Mr. Ranjit Kumar gave straw and magnets to the students and told them to make any structure which comes to their minds with the help of these things. They prepared different types of very attractive models. This activity gave them full entertainment and exercise of brain. In another session, some puzzles were solved by the students.



Parallel to hands-on activity, demonstrations on some experiments on light were done by Mr Jai Prakash of Anveshika. He talked about the basic principles of reflection and diffraction and showed these phenomena by some innovative experiments. An interaction was done by Mr Ajit Agrawal, Manager Saraswati Gyan Mandir, Indira Nagar with the students and teachers present.

## Visit to Siwan (Bihar)

Shiksha Sopan team members, Dr H C Verma, Mr Amit K Bajpai, Mr Anurag Pandey and Mr Ranjit Kumar conducted a two-day science learning workshop at Narendrapura village near Siwan on 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2013. A project for rural upliftment called "Parivartan" by Taxila Education Society hosted the whole workshop.

The programme started with interaction with students. Narendrapura is a remote village and Parivartan has a component where children are called in evenings and given academic assistance. Together with these children some students from Siwan schools were also invited. Dr Verma talked about doing new things, beyond the textbooks and classroom.



The children were given exposure to several Science related activities. Mr Amit Bajpai with Mr Ranjit Kumar demonstrated some science experiments and guided the students to do some hands-on activities. Mr Anuarg Pandey had taken science classes by showing some video lectures.

Teachers from Patna DPS and some Siwan schools had come for the interaction. This was done by Dr H C Verma in the afternoon, where teachers got some innovative ideas for improving the style of their teaching using video clips.

### Visit to Dhanbad (Jharkhand)

Shiksha Sopan members Dr H C Verma and Mr Amit K Bajpai, gave a one day teachers workshop at DAV Public School, Dhanbad on 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2013. Altogether, they gave three sessions, an interaction with class 11<sup>th</sup> students (about 600) for 1.5 hours, interaction with class 12<sup>th</sup> students (about 500) for 1 hour and physics teachers (about 80) for 5 hours.

In the whole workshop Dr Verma discussed a lot of science with students and teachers. Dr R K Awasthi from Agra, our Senior Resource Person had actively participated in this workshop and gave a session with Mr Amit K Bajpai to the teachers. They demonstrated the experiments based on optics, mechanics and electromagnetism.
